RESOLUTION DESIGNATING MILAM COUNTY A SECOND AMENDMENT SANCTUARY

WHEREAS acting through the United States Constitution, the people created government to be their agent in the exercise of a few defined powers, while reserving to the citizens the right to decide on matters which concern their lives, liberty, and property in the ordinary course of affairs:

WHEREAS the Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America states, "A well-regulated Militia being necessary to the security of a free-state, the right of the People to keep and bear arms, shall not be infringed" and that right applied to State and Local governments through the Fourteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America;

WHEREAS Article I, Section 23 of the Texas Constitution states, "Every citizen shall have the right to keep and bear arms in the lawful defense of himself or the State; but the Legislature shall have power, by law, to regulate the wearing of arms, with a view to prevent crime."

WHEREAS local governments have the legal authority to refuse to cooperate with state and federal firearms laws that violate those rights enumerated in the Constitution;

WHEREAS both the Sheriff of Milam County and District Attorney of Milam County refuse to enforce unconstitutional firearms restrictions.

NOW THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Milam County, State of Texas, hereby RESOLVE to support the decisions of the Sheriff of Milam County and the District Attorney of Milam County to refuse enforcing unconstitutional firearms restrictions against any citizen and further that no County funds shall be budgeted or expended in pursuit of any unconstitutional infringement on the right to keep and bear arms as set forth in the Constitution of the United States and the Texas Constitution.
