The following items will be addressed:

1. A quorum will be established and the Court will convene.
2. Invocation.
3. Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and to the Texas Flag.
4. Discuss the minutes of previous Commissioner's Court meetings and take any necessary action regarding approval, corrections and/or changes of the minutes of prior Court action.
5. Public Participation:
 - a. The Milam County Commissioners Court will entertain any reasonable request from any citizen who wishes to address the Court, so long as the remarks are made pursuant to respectful decorum, the Texas Government Code and limited to five minutes or less.
6. Milam County Proposed Amended 2022 Tax Rate:
 - a. Discuss and take any necessary action to set the 2022 proposed amended Milam County tax rate as follows:
 - i. Proposed M&O 2022 tax rate at .614053 per \$100.00 of evaluation;
 - ii. Proposed I&S 2022 tax rate at .047303 per \$100.00 of evaluation; and
 - iii. Proposed total tax rate at .661356 per \$100.00 of evaluation.
7. Setting Public Hearings:
 - a. Discuss and take any necessary action to set public hearings regarding the proposed amended 2023 Milam County budget at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, September 26, 2022.
 - b. Discuss and take any necessary action to set a public hearing on the proposed amended 2022 tax rate at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, September 26, 2022.
8. Burn Ban:
 - a. Discuss and take any necessary action to reinstate a burn ban for Milam County.
9. Ranch Road Development:

- a. Receive and discuss a presentation from Ranch Road Development regarding a proposed Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone for the Cornerstone Subdivision project in Rockdale, Texas.

10. Discuss and take any necessary action to pay the bills of Milam County, Texas.

11. Discuss and take any necessary action to adjourn the Milam County Commissioners Court.
