MILAM COUNTY COURTROOM ATTIRE AND CONDUCT

ALL PERSONS present in the Courtroom shall be neatly dressed in a manner that shows dignity and respect for the Court.

Attire that is Unacceptable in the Courtroom:

- Shorts
- Cut-offs
- Baggy Pants
- Cropped Shirts
- Low cut blouses/halter tops
- Oversized coats
- Flip Flops
- Hats
- Pajamas/sweatpants
- See through tops
- Clothing with offensive, vulgar, racist, sexist, obscene, suggestive words, slogans, or pictures
- Clothing that promotes violence, sex acts, drug use, illegal or inappropriate activity or profanity
- Ripped or torn jeans

Conduct in the Courtroom:

NO cell phones, laptops or tablets are allowed in the courtroom NO weapons are allowed in the courtroom OR in the courthouse Do not approach the Judge's bench without permission Do not chew gum or bring food or drinks in the courtroom

No recording devices are allowed without judicial approval

Address the court as "Judge" or "Your Honor"

Respect court personnel at all times

Persons outside the courtroom shall not disrupt court proceedings

Children may not be brought into the Courtroom without consent of the court

Do not enter or leave the Courtroom excessively and do not slam the doors

Racist, sexist, obscene or profane language is prohibited unless it is pertinent to a case and is elicited and quoted from facts in the case.
