Palasota (referred to hereinafter as "Grantor"), conveyed to Timothy C. AND WHEREAS, the Note, the Other Indebtedness, and liens evidenced by the Deed of Trust were modified and/or extended by that certain Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization in Bankruptcy Case No. 14-60931-rbk-11 styled *In re: Ricky Joe Palasota*, in the United States Bankruptcy Court, Western District of Texas, Waco Division (the "Palasota Bankruptcy Case"), and the automatic stay in said Palasota Bankruptcy Case was terminated as confirmed by Amended Order Confirming Termination of Automatic Stay Under §362(c), signed June 17, 2019. The Note, the Other Indebtedness, and liens evidenced by the Deed of Trust were also modified and/or extended by that certain Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization in Bankruptcy Case No. 14-60932-rbk-11 styled *In re: BVS Construction, Inc.*, and in Bankruptcy Case No. 19-60004-rbk-11 styled *In re: BVS Construction, Inc.*, in the United State Bankruptcy Court, Western District of Texas, Waco Division (the "BVS Bankruptcy Cases"). The automatic stay in the BVS Bankruptcy Cases was terminated under the terms of a Chapter 11 Plan, as confirmed by that certain Notice of Termination of Stay filed April 17, 2021, in Case No. 19-60004-rbk-11.

AND WHEREAS, Prosperity Bank is holder and owner of the Indebtedness evidenced by the Note and the Other Indebtedness, and liens securing same, and any and all renewals, extensions, modifications, forbearances of same, and is entitled to receive all amounts due thereunder, as successor in interest to First Victoria National Bank;
