Dear Judge Young:

As required by HB2309, please accept this notification on behalf of the City of Thorndale for our upcoming General Election & Special Election. The City of Thorndale ordered the May 1, 2021 elections at their regular meeting held on January 13, 2021. Thorndale ISD will be cancelling their uncontested election.

The City of Thorndale will hold a General Election to elect two council members. The mayor election is uncontested. The Special Election is the reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Thorndale at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (1/4%) to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

Early voting will be conducted at the Thorndale ISD Administration Office, 300 N. Main Street, Thorndale, Texas, from April 19, 2021 through April 27, 2021 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Early voting hours will be extended at the same location on April 21 and April 27, 2021 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

On Election Day, May 1, 2021, voting will be held at the Thorndale Senior Citizens Center, 200 S. Cornelius Street, Thorndale, Texas. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
