**WAIVERS OF JURY TRIAL - READING OF INFORMATION - TEN DAYS TO PREPARE FOR TRIAL
COURT'S ADMONISHMENT - WAIVER OF PRE-SENTENCE REPORT AND PLEA AGREEMENT**

____ Comes now the Defendant, Pro Se, having waived the right to and attorney, or along with Defendant's attorney, and the attorney for the State in the above-styled and numbered cause, and waives the right to trial by jury and the reading of the information, and if applicable, waives the ten days allowed for preparation for trial. The Defendant and the State hereby enter an announcement of ready in this cause.

The plea recommendation set forth below is agreed to by Defendant, Defendant's attorney, and the State's attorney, as evidenced by their respective signatures below. The Defendant understands that if Defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere and the punishment assessed by the Court does not exceed the punishment recommended, an appeal herein may only be prosecuted with the permission of the trial court. All written motions on file are hereby waived. The Defendant affirmatively waives all rights to appeal this cause.

The Defendant acknowledges that Defendant is aware of the full range of punishment provided by law for this offense.

If the plea recommendation is for deferred adjudication supervision, the Defendant further acknowledges and understands the following: that on a violation of a condition of supervision Defendant may be arrested and detained; that in such case Defendant would be entitled to a hearing limited to the determination by the Court whether to proceed with an adjudication of guilt on the original charge; that no appeal may be taken from this determination; and after an adjudication of guilt, all proceedings, including assessment of punishment, pronouncement of sentence, or granting of community supervision may continue as if the adjudication of guilt had not been deferred; and that the Court may assess punishment anywhere within the range provided by law for this offense upon such an adjudication.

The Defendant acknowledges that if he/she is not a citizen of the United States of America, a plea of guilty or nolo contendere for the offense charged may result in deportation, exclusion from admission to this country, or denial of naturalization under federal law.

The Defendant waives the right to remain silent and the right to be confronted by the witnesses, and the Defendant further states that, "I am the person named in the information filed in the above-styled and numbered cause and judicially confess to the offense alleged or stipulate that admissible evidence would be sufficient for a conviction of that offense." The Defendant waives a pre-sentence report and the right to have an alcohol evaluation performed prior to sentencing.
