I hereby enter a plea of “no contest” to the violation of _____ and waive my right to trial. I request the Court allow me to complete a Deferred Disposition for this case. I understand if I successfully complete the terms of the Deferred Disposition by the due date established by the court, my case will be dismissed. If I do not complete the terms of the Deferred Disposition by the due date, I will be sent a notice to appear in court to show cause why I did not complete the terms of this deferral. If cause is not sufficient, I understand the Deferred Disposition will be revoked and I will be found guilty of the offense. The conviction will be reported to the Department of Public Safety to be placed on my driving record.

I understand that the deferral period is 30 days and agree to the terms of this deferred disposition which are:

1. The payment must be made immediately equal to the current balance of the case \$_____. (The amount may be obtained by calling 254-697-7004.) Payment can be made by cashier’s check or money order. Online payment must be authorized by the Judge.
2. Notify the court of any change of name or address.
3. Commit no other violations in Milam County for the entirety of the deferral period.
