The Milam County Commissioners Court will convene on Monday, May 23, 2022 beginning at 5:00 p.m. The Court will convene in person at the Milam County Courthouse in the Milam County Courtroom located at 102 S. Fannin Ave., Cameron, Texas. Court proceedings will also be broadcast by Facebook Live.

The following items will be addressed:

1. A quorum will be established and the Court will convene.
2. Invocation.
3. Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and to the Texas Flag.
4. Public Hearing Regarding Reauthorization of Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements:
  - a. Discuss and take any necessary action to open and conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption, amendment, repeal or reauthorization of Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatement, giving members of the public a reasonable opportunity to be heard.
  - b. Discuss and take any necessary action to close the public hearing regarding the adoption, amendment, repeal or reauthorization of Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatement.
5. Reauthorization of Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatement:
  - a. Discuss and take any necessary action to adopt, amend, repeal or reauthorize Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatement and adopt a resolution stating that Milam County elects to become eligible to participate in tax abatements.
6. Public Hearing Regarding Possible Creation of a Reinvestment Zone:
  - a. Discuss and take any necessary action to conduct a public hearing regarding the creation of a Reinvestment Zone to be known as "Milam County Reinvestment Zone-Cattlemen Solar Park II LLC" for purposes of potential tax abatement to provide economic development within the County as described in the application for Tax Abatement on file with the Milam County Clerk.
  - b. Discuss and take any necessary action to close the public hearing regarding the creation of a Reinvestment Zone to be known as "Milam County Reinvestment Zone-Cattlemen Solar Park II LLC" for purposes of potential tax abatement to provide economic development within the County as described in the application for Tax Abatement on file with the Milam County Clerk.

7. Reinvestment Zone:

- a. Discuss and take any necessary action to create a reinvestment zone for the purposes of tax abatement to provide economic development within Milam County pursuant to Chapter 312 of the Texas Tax Code. Such reinvestment zone to be known as Milam County Reinvestment Zone-Cattlemen Solar Park II LLC which is located as described in the application for tax abatement filed by Cattlemen Solar Park II LLC.

8. Discuss and take any necessary action to adjourn the Milam County Commissioners Court.
