Dear Casa McKibben,


This Letter will state and confirm our agreement of this date as follows:

- (1). MILAM COUNTY agrees to pay CASA MCKIBBEN (MCKIBBEN) for the housing of stray and abandoned dogs and/or cats rescued inside the boundaries of Milam County, Texas.
- (2). MILAM COUNTY agrees to pay MCKIBBEN the sum of TWO THOUSAND AND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 CENTS (\$2,500.00) per month for the term of this agreement. Said agreement to be in effect from January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023.
- (3). MCKIBBEN agrees to the periodic inspection by a representative of Milam County or of the Milam Touch of Love organization to determine the condition of the kennels and to verify stray and abandoned dogs and/or cats from Milam County are still on said property.
- (4). MCKIBBEN will submit invoices at the last business day of the month either in person or via email to the County Judge's office.
- (5). MCKIBBEN AGREES TO PROTECT, DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS AND RELEASE MILAM COUNTY, (INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY REFERRED TO AS THE "COUNTY"), FROM AND AGAINST ANY MANNER OF LOSS, LIABILITY, CLAIM, DAMAGE, PENALTY OR COST (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES) ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT.

This agreement is approved by the Milam County Commissioners Court this the 27th of February 2023, and shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators, representatives, successors and/or assigns.

We evaluated an overweight transport proposed to cross the County Road 279 bridge over Hog Creek, in Milam County, NBI 17-166-0-AA01-51-003. The bridge was constructed in 2021; it is 60 ft long and 19'-11" wide.

The transport is 18 ft wide with 8 tires per axle. The clear spacing between inner tires is 4'-10". These dimensions are shown on the attached diagram.

The 7" thick concrete deck provides good distribution to steel beams. The beams are spaced at 1'-8 ¾". Placing timber mats on the deck will improve load distribution to the deck and steel beams, helping to ensure all beams are loaded equally.

Placing 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick timber mats across the bridge deck will increase the effective tire contact area, for pairs of tires, from approximately 170 sq. in. (20" width x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " length), to 555 sq. in. (30" width x 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " length).

Placing the timber mats on the bridge deck will reduce bearing pressure from 87 psi at the base of a pair of wheels, to 27 psi on the concrete deck.
