Public attendance will be limited due to COVID-19 spacing requirements and admittance will be done on a first come, first serve basis.

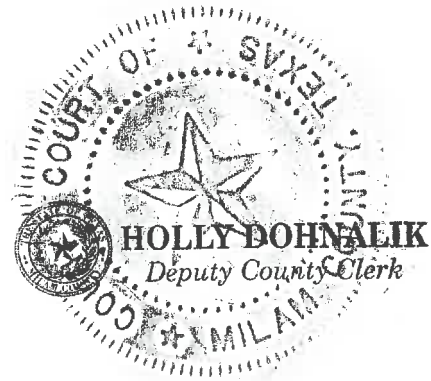
