HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY AS REQUIRED BY THE MILAM COUNTY DISASTER ORDER OF JUNE 25, 2020 EFFECTIVE 12:01 a.m., June 29, 2020

The Milam County disaster order currently in effect provides the wearing of a face covering in certain situations. The express purpose and intent of the order is to limit the spread of the COVID-19 virus. The order specifically requires:

- a. All businesses and commercial entities shall require all employees, visitors, including but not limited to patrons, contractors, volunteers and vendors, to wear face coverings that cover the nose and mouth while on the business's premises.
- b. All businesses and commercial entities shall deny entrance onto their premises and/or services to any person who refuses or fails to comply with this order.

Pursuant to the order it is the policy of this establishment that all employees, visitors, patrons, contractors, volunteers and vendors wear a face covering that covers the nose and mouth while on these premises; unless one has a bonafide and verifiable medical or psychological reason which prohibits wearing a face covering.
